PROCLAMATION – KENTUCKY NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE

Angela Garnett with the Kentucky Native American Heritage Commission was present to discuss a Proclamation honoring Native Americans. Ms. Garnett informed Council that she had been to several city council meetings trying to get them all to sign proclamations. Ms. Garnett stated that Indigenous People's Day falls on Columbus Day, so the celebration itself is really up to the town, if you want to do a parade or a legal observance, that's up to you.

It was agreed by the Council to have Larry G. Bryson draft a Proclamation and officially sign it at a later date. Mayor Rudder suggested that when the Proclamation is signed, send it to the London Tourism Commission and have the Tourism Commission plan something around the October date.

PROCLAMATION – DRUG COURT MONTH

Mayor Rudder presented the Council Members with a Proclamation proclaiming May 2018 as Drug Court Month. Mayor Rudder read the Proclamation.

ECONOMY INN – TERESA HODGE

Teresa Hodge was present as it relates to the Economy Inn. Ms. Hodge, owner of Revive Salon and Spa, filed a Complaint with the City about the amount of trash and drug paraphernalia that was spilling over onto her business from the Economy Inn. Dev Patel, owner of the Economy Inn, appeared before council and stated that the Inn does not support drug use and said he would make every effort to make sure it stops. Mr. Patel informed Council at the September 2017 council meeting that he would increase the amount of cameras and hire a full time security guard, in which he has failed to hire a security guard. Mayor Rudder suggested that a letter be sent to the business stating Mr. Patel has not done what he said he was going to do and allow him 30 days to complete that requirement of getting a security guard or the City would move forward with the next step. The next step involves a proposed Ordinance which would allow the City to declare the property as public nuisance and allow them to close the property.
