A Summary of City Ordinance No. 2024-05 entitled

"An Ordinance allowing the Use of UTVs on Streets in the City of London; Permit Required and

Permit Fee for Golf Carts and UTVs; Fines and Code Enforcement"

This Summary of Ordinance No. 2024-05 as entitled above, adopts the definition of "Utility Terrain Vehicle" ("UTV") as in KRS 189.515 and 16 FFR Sec. 1420.3, except in this Ordinance a UTV shall accommodate more than one rider (a "side-by-side").

This Ordinance is authorized by KRS 189.281, KRS 189.286 and KRS 189.515(7)(c).

Compliance with the Ordinance requires compliance with KRS 189.281 and KRS 189.515. Golf carts and UTVs may be operated on any city streets that are not Kentucky or federally funded highways.

The City Clerk will issue a permit of \$35.00 for each golf cart or UTV upon as showing of proof of inspection, proof of insurance and maintain a record of all permits and stickers issued. The sticker is to be displayed on the UTV or golf cart and shall authorized the use of the golf cart or UTV on the streets and roadways of the City as stated above.

Citations for noncompliance with this Ordinance is to the Code Enforcement Board ("CEB"). Violation of the Ordinance first offense is not less than \$100 and not more than \$250 which the person may elect to pay to for a first offense of \$100, rather than a hearing before the CEB. Subsequent violations within a 2 year period are \$250-\$500. Violations of other traffic state laws are within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Laurel District and Circuit Courts.

The Ordinance contains severable parts and does not otherwise change or amend City

Ordinance 2017-06, other than as to enforcement with the CEB, permit fees and fines.
