**AN ORDINANCE RENAMING WESTINGHOUSE DRIVE AS
HIGHLANDS DIVERSIFIED DRIVE**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LONDON, as follows:

In recognition of Highlands' significant contributions to our community and their ongoing commitment to fostering career opportunities, we are changing the name of Westinghouse Drive to Highlands Diversified Drive. Highlands Diversified has played a pivotal role in shaping careers and expanding opportunities in our community. This renaming initiative seeks to honor and celebrate their longstanding dedication to our community's growth and prosperity. By dedicating this road to Highlands, we aim to highlight their positive impact and express our gratitude for their continued investment in our community's future.

Highlands Diversified has expanded its business operations in the City of London that will offer additional employment opportunities to residents of both the City of London and Laurel County and to surrounding counties. This will improve the economy of London and will lead to business opportunities for others and provide valuable products in the local and national commerce.

For all of the reasons stated hereinabove and pursuant to KRS 82.400 and other applicable law, the City Council of the City of London does hereby change the name of Westinghouse Drive to Highlands Diversified Drive. This drive encircles building and structures and joins East Hal Rogers Parkway. It is the further directions of the Council that London/Laurel County 911 Dispatch, the U.S. Post Office, the Laurel County Court Clerk and any other necessary agencies be notified by the London City Clerk of the name change of the drive.

Any Ordinances or part of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall become effective on publication.
