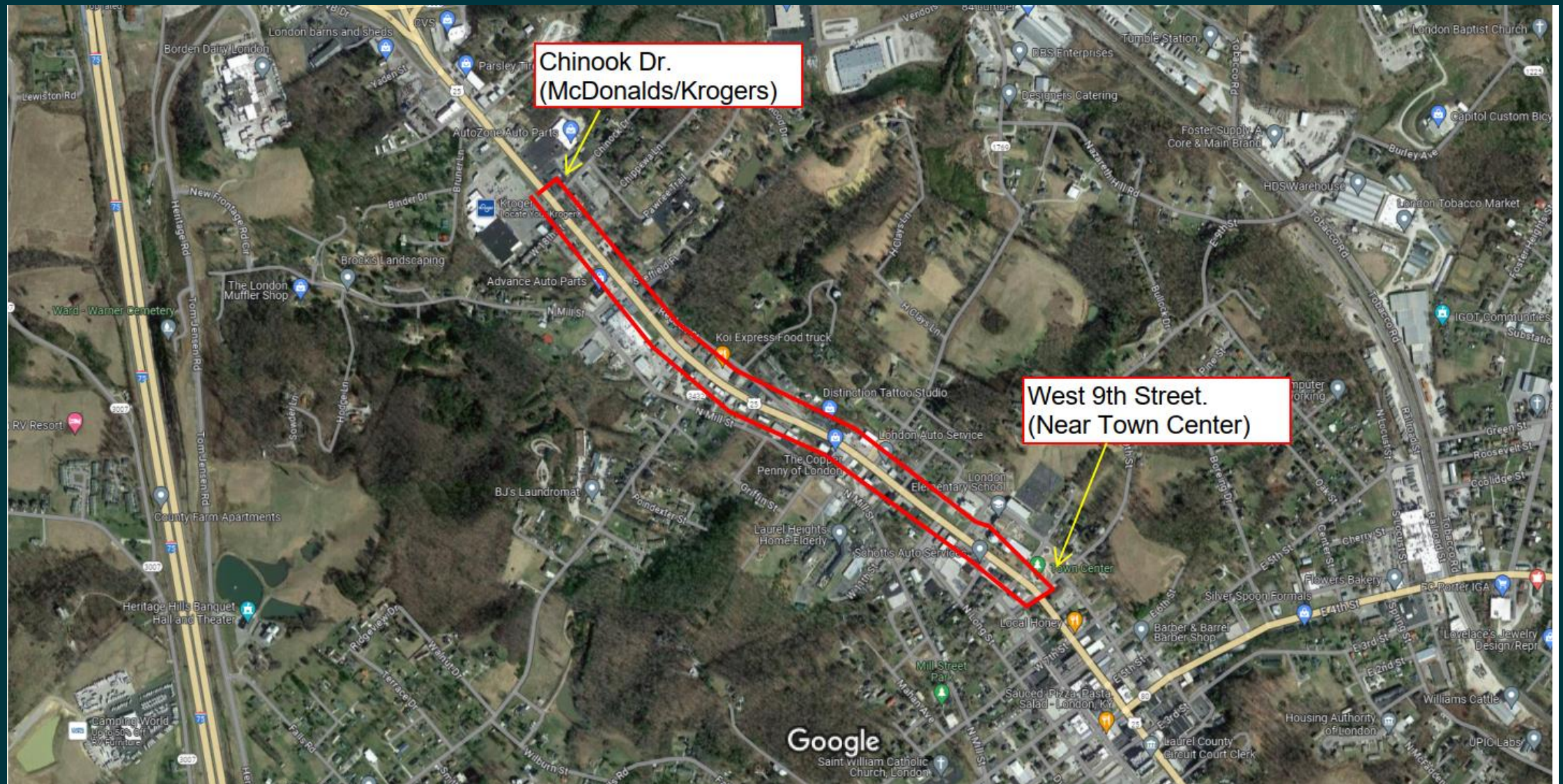

# Project Area

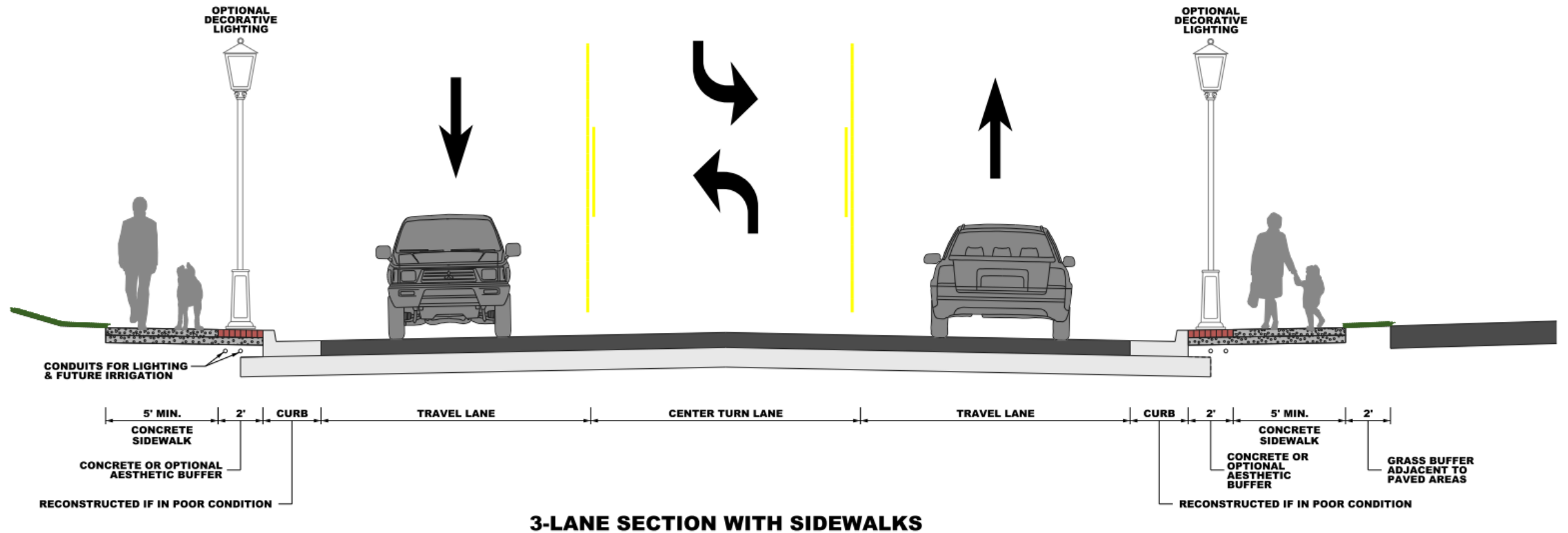




# Project Overview

- Preliminary Engineering – Develop a concept to advance to final design (construction drawings)
- Review existing conditions / site assessment / ADA compliance
- Development of concept(s)
- Public engagement
- Selection of recommended concept (alternative)
- Complete preliminary engineering and advance to final design

# Proposed Typical Section



- Sidewalk width will be a minimum of 5'
- A 2' buffer area behind the curb for separation from the travel lane
- Buffer area – concrete or optional aesthetic material
- Conduits for possible lighting and future irrigation in buffer area
- Optional decorative lighting

# Field Assessment Summary

## Sidewalks segments

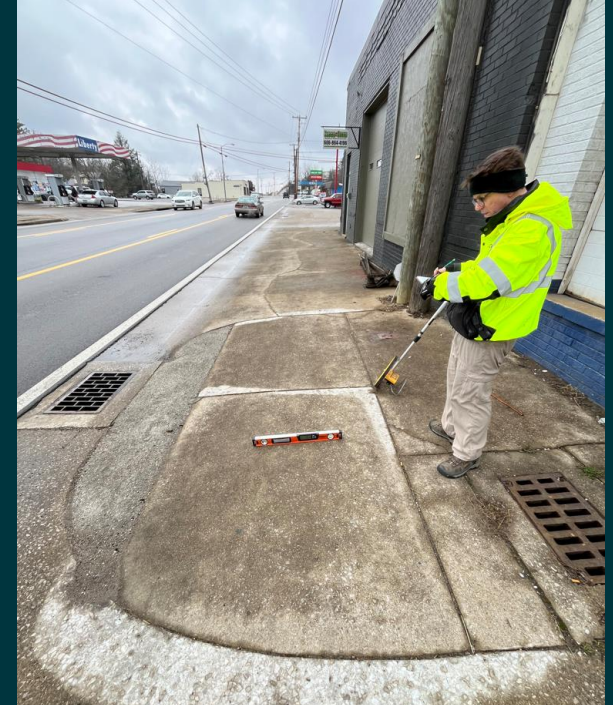
- Sidewalk is generally in worst condition on the east side, only 36% rated very good versus 66% on the west side.

## Curb Ramps

- Only 30% of the curb ramps in the corridor are ADA compliant for cross slope.

## Entrances

- Only 16% of entrances have an ADA compliant cross slope.



# Challenge Areas

Project Team (City of London, KYTC, AECOM design team) participated in a field review and identified following challenge areas to develop concepts for.

- Narrow sidewalk in front of former attorney's office north of 11th Street, east side.
- Retaining wall fronting Family Dollar Store north of Moren Road, east side.
- Rueben Street (south connection), east side.
- Intersection of West 16th Street (potential new connection to Reuben Street), east side.
- Narrow sidewalk at Reuben Street (north connection), east side.





# Access Management Opportunities

Develop an access management plan. The purpose of this plan will be to identify areas of existing open access that could be reduced or eliminated.



# Public Engagement

  - City will have exhibits for review

# Next Steps

- Review and compile public input comments – July 2024
- Meeting with project team (City of London, KYTC, design team) to discuss public comments and make recommendations – August 2024
- Advance recommended concepts to the Preliminary Line and Grade Meeting – (review recommended concept, cost estimate, right of way and utility impacts) – Fall 2024
- Final Design – field survey, utility coordination and development of construction plans
