AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF GREER AVENUE TO  
AZBILL STREET


Whereas there exists a portion of the street known as Greer Avenue and whereas the City of London wishes to change Greer Avenue to Azbill Street so that the street is named continuously,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the portion of street now known and marked as Greer Avenue be and is hereby changed, in name, to Azbill Street.
2. This area of street is approximately from Main Street, beginning in an east direction to the intersection of Reams and (present name) Azbill Street.
3. That the City Street Department shall erect signs in keeping with this ordinance.
4. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
