ORDINANCE NO. 1006

AN ORDINANCE NAMING STREETS: ROBINETTE LANE
DON'S DRIVE
FOUNTAIN LANE

1. WHEREAS, there exists a street off of North McWhorter Street that the City of London wishes to name Robinette Lane,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

That the following street be and is hereby named Robinette Lane.

This street is last road on the right (east) before entering the Daniel Boone Parkway off of McWhorter Street.

2. WHEREAS, there exists a street in a southerly direction off Myers Baker Road near the Wal-mart Shopping Center, and,

WHEREAS, the City of London wishes to change the name of this address and name this street to Don's Drive,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

That the street off the 192 Bypass, right on Walton Drive, and the 1st Road to the Left be and is hereby named Don's Drive.

3. WHEREAS, there exists a street off of west 16th street that exists separate from W. 16th Street and,

WHEREAS, the City of London wishes to change the name of this address and name this Street to Fontaine Lane,


BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

That the 1st lane on the right, past the 4-way stop off of West 16th street be and is hereby named Fontaine Lane.

4. That the City Street Department shall erect signs in keeping with this ordinance.


5. That these streets named are given only as street names for Robinette Lane and Fontaine Lane and are intended for the City to provide maintenance to these streets
