ORDINANCE NO 1011**


**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FOUR-WAY STOP AT THE
INTERSECTION OF BROAD STREET AND FOURTH (4TH) STREET**

WHEREAS, there is an increased flow of traffic in the area of the intersection of Broad Street and Fourth Street and the same has caused potentially unsafe conditions to exist.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

That stop signs shall be and the Street Department of the City of London is hereby directed to erect four (4) stop signs, creating a four (4) way stop of traffic at the intersection of Broad Street and Fourth (4th) Street.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
