ORDINANCE NO. 2002-03

AN ORDINANCE NAMING A STREET SLED LANE

WHEREAS, there exists a street that intersects with Calvary Court from West Highway 80 that, the City of London wishes to name Sled Lane,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the following street be and is hereby named Sled Lane.
2. This street begins at West Highway 80 and runs approximately 100 feet uphill across Calvary Court.

AN ORDINANCE NAMING A STREET MCKINNEY STREET

WHEREAS, there exists a street that intersects with North Mill Street that, the City of London wishes to name McKinney Street,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

3. That the following street be and is hereby named McKinney Street.
4. This street is approximately 0.2 miles past the north intersection of North Mill Street and West 17th Street, it turns right off of North Mill Street. It is approximately 0.3 miles.
5. That the City Street Department shall erect signs in keeping with this ordinance.
6. That these streets named are given names of Sled Lane and McKinney Street and it is intended that the City will provide maintenance to these streets.
7. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
