AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATE FOR WASTE AT
TRANSFER STATION FOR USERS OTHER THAN CITY RESIDENTS

Whereas the City of London("City") has signed a contract with Scott Solid Waste Disposal Company ("Scott") for solid waste disposal and transportation of solid waste, and

Whereas Scott has indicated that it has no objection to the City accepting waste at the city transfer station from haulers other than the city, and


Whereas this will ensure the City and the surrounding area with a feasible alternative for garbage disposal, and

Whereas this will provide assistance to both the City and surrounding areas,


BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a rate of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) per ton is established as a rate for garbage originating in Laurel County and received at the city transfer station.
2. That a rate of twenty six dollars (\$26.00) per ton is established as a rate for garbage originating outside of Laurel County; of the fee of twenty six dollars (\$26.00), one dollar (\$1.00) per ton shall be paid to Laurel County Fiscal Court as a host fee.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, except this Ordinance shall in no manner have any effect on Ordinance No. 972.
