
**AN ORDINANCE REZONING GRIFFIN PIE COMPANY, INC., A/K/A
FLOWERS SNACK OF LONDON, LLC PROPERTY LOCATED ON
LOCUST, 5TH AND ROBINSON STREETS FROM RESIDENTIAL TO
INDUSTRIAL ZONE.**

Whereas it has been represented to the City Council of the City of London, Kentucky, that legal notices were posted and a public hearing was conducted by the London Laurel County Joint Planning Commission on February 11, 2003 and that all property owners entitled to legal notice were notified of the Public Hearing of the proposed zone change, and


Whereas it has also been represented to the City Council of the City of London, Kentucky that the London Laurel County Joint Planning Commission has made appropriate findings in keeping with Kentucky law, particularly with regard to KRS Chapter 100, and has recommended this Zone change from Residential to Industrial.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Notwithstanding any prior ordinance or zoning designation, the property located at the corner of Locust, 5th and Robinson Street presently owned by Griffin Pie Company, Inc., a/k/a Flowers Snack of London, LLC, be and is hereby given the Zone designation of "Industrial." Any ordinances or parts of ordinances to the contrary be and are hereby repealed.
2. This property is otherwise more particularly described in Deed Book 409 at page 543, Deed Book 391 at page 592, both records of the Laurel County Court Clerk's Office.
3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication.
