ORDINANCE NO. 2003-05

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING A PUBLIC PASSWAY KNOWN AS E. TENTH STREET AND CLOSING A PORTION OF THE PUBLIC PASSWAY KNOWN AS HILL STREET FROM EAST ELEVENTH STREET TO MAPLE STREET

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of London has been requested by the property owner in and abutting the street known as E. Tenth Street and,

WHEREAS, the provisions of KRS 82.405 have been followed and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has made Findings of Fact pursuant to KRS 82.405, these findings being that all of the property owners in or abutting the public way known as E. Tenth Street, which begins at Main Street and runs in a northeasterly direction and dead ends on property owned on three sides by the Laurel County Board of Education.

And whereas the City Council has made Findings of Fact pursuant to KRS 82.405, these findings being that all of the property owners in or abutting the public way known as a portion of Hill Street that runs through the London Elementary School campus in a southeasterly direction from East Eleventh (11<sup>th</sup>) Street in a northerly direction to East Maple Street. No part of East Maple Street or East Eleventh (11<sup>th</sup>) Street are effected by this closing. The City Council further states that it finds the above streets should be closed for the safety and welfare of the public and children who attend the London Elementary School, and the Laurel County Board of Education having requested that these public ways be closed and has given written notarized consent to the closing.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

That the public way known as E. Tenth Street, which begins at Main Street and runs in a northeasterly direction and dead ends on property owned on three sides by the Laurel County Board of Education, in the City of London be, and is hereby closed.

That the public way known as a portion of Hill Street that runs through the London Elementary School campus in a southeasterly direction from East Eleventh (11<sup>th</sup>) Street in a northerly direction to East Maple Street and is owned by the Laurel County Board of Education is hereby closed.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication and shall be recorded in the office of the Laurel County Court Clerk.
