



AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF MAYOR OF THE CITY  
OF LONDON, KENTUCKY AS A FULL TIME POSITION AND SETTING THE  
MINIMUM COMPENSATION OF FULL TIME MAYOR


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, AS  
FOLLOWS:

Whereas the Kentucky General Assembly has amended KRS 38A.075 to allow cities of the second to the fifth class to find and declare the office of Mayor to be considered a full-time office and to fix the minimum compensation; it is therefore the finding of the City Council of the City of London, that:

1. The position of Mayor of the City of London be and is hereby established as being a full time position.
2. The compensation for the full-time position of Mayor of the City of London shall be no less than minimum of Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000.00) per year.
3. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the above be and are hereby repealed.
4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication.
