AN ORDINANCE DECLARING STREET ADJACENT TO COOK TIRE A CITY  
STREET AND NAMING THE SAME COOK TIRE LANE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LONDON AS FOLLOWS:


1. Whereas the below described property has been used by the general public in an unrestricted manner for more than five (5) years, and
2. Whereas it is the desire of the City Council, pursuant to a request by Ted Cook and Debbie Cook, his wife, that this street be declared a city street, The City Council of the City of London, does hereby declare the following described property to be dedicated to the City of London as a city street and accepts the same as a city street for all city purposes and in keeping with KRS 82.400. This street is described as follows:

Begin at the eastern boundary line of the property of the first parties where it joins on Highway 1006 and shall run with the eastern boundary line in a southerly direction to the property owned by Ted Cook and Debbie Cook.


3. It is further the finding of the City Council of the City of London that this street shall be known as Cook Tire Lane.
