ORDINANCE NO. 2006-09

AN ORDINANCE BANNING SKATEBOARDS FROM USE ON CITY STREETS
AND SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF LONDON AND FROM PUBLIC AND
PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE PROPERTY
OWNERS

Whereas the use of skateboards on City sidewalks and streets has created a safety issue for the skateboarders, motorists and pedestrians, and

Whereas property damage has resulted from the use of skateboards on public and private property,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall ride a skateboard on City of London streets or sidewalks.
2. No person shall ride a skateboard on public or private property in the City of London without written permission from the property owner, which shall be produced upon request by any city of London official including but not limited to any City of London police officer.
3. The first offense, the London City Police shall confiscate the skateboard of any person using the skateboard on the streets or sidewalks of the City of London. The London City Police ("Police") shall retain the skateboard of any person under the age of eighteen (18) at the office of the London City Police and shall only return the same to a parent of the skateboarder, but only upon documentation that the person requesting the return of the skateboard is the parent of the skateboarder or at such time as the skateboarder becomes eighteen (18) years of age.
4. Any subsequent violation of this Ordinance shall result in a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) and payment for any damage caused by the skateboarding activity and confiscation of the skateboard in keeping with the procedure outlined in #3 above.
5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon publication. Any Ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed.
