 ORDINANCE NO. 2012-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2012-03 ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING FINES, PRESCRIBING NEW PARKING FEES AND FINES”

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS, VIZ:

(1) No charges are made for parking spaces in City lots or along city streets by the City of London for up to two (2) hours, except for permit parking. However, except for permit parking in City lots, shall exceed two (2) hours.

(2) The City of London hereby establishes the following fines:

- (a) (1) No person shall park in a City parking space for more than two (2) hours. Overtime parking in a City parking space (on streets) is defined as parking in any City parking space for more than two (2) hours.
 The penalty for such overtime parking is.....\$10.00
- (2) If paid after forty-eight (48) hours.....\$20.00
- ~~(b) (1) Overtime parking in a City parking space (on streets) for four (4) hours or more.....\$10.00~~
- ~~(2) If paid after forty eight (48) hours.....\$20.00~~
- (b) (1) Parking on Sidewalk – paid within forty-eight (48) hours.....\$10.00
- (2) If paid after forty-eight (48) hours.....\$20.00
- (c) (1) Parking in Fire / Safety Zone – paid within forty-eight (48) hours.....\$25.00
- (2) If paid after forty-eight (48) hours.....\$50.00
- (d) (1) Parking on Wrong Side of Street – paid within forty-eight (48) hours.....\$10.00
- (2) If paid after forty-eight (48) hours.....\$20.00
- (e) (1) Parking over the line, occupying two (2) parking spaces.....\$10.00
- (2) If paid after forty-eight (48) hours.....\$20.00
- (f) (1) Parking on Yellow Line or Curb– paid within forty-eight (48) hours.....\$25.00
- (2) If paid after forty-eight (48) hours.....\$50.00
- (g) (1) Parking in handicap space without handicap display – paid within forty-eight (48) hours.....\$40.00
- (2) If paid after forty-eight (48) hours.....\$60.00

(h) Failure to display handicap sign / tag.....\$5.00

(3) All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

(4) This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication.
