**AN ORDINANCE CLOSING A PUBLIC WAY
FROM SUBSTATION STREET TO TOBACCO RD**

Whereas, the City Council of the City of London, Kentucky, has been requested to close a public way from the end of the paved area of Substation Street to Tobacco Road, and,


Whereas, the provisions of KRS 82.405 have been followed and the City Council has made Findings of Fact in keeping with the requirements of KRS 82.405, and has specifically found that all of the owners of real estate that abut or adjoin the public way have given their written notarized consent or request for the closing of the public way,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

That the public passway behind and between Warehouse #1 and Warehouse #2 of the New London Tobacco Market, Inc., from the paved end of Substation Street to Tobacco Road,

BE AND IS HEREBY CLOSED.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication. Pursuant to KRS 82.405, this ordinance shall be recorded by the City Clerk in the office of the Laurel County Court Clerk's office after its effective date of publication.
