AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 827 ENTITLED AN
ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 780 WHICH WAS ENTITLED "AN
ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 636 WHICH ESTABLISHED THE
PRIVILEGED LICENSE FEES AND CITY STICKERS FOR THE OPERATION OF
MOTOR VEHICLES UPON THE CITY STREETS OF THE CITY OF LONDON,
KENTUCKY; PROVIDING FOR DISPLAY OF CITY STICKERS ON MOTOR
VEHICLES AND PENALTIES FOR DELAY IN THE PURCHASE OF STICKERS
AND CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE ORDINANCE FOR THE
YEAR 1976."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNSEL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY,
AS FOLLOWS:

- . WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of London has recommended the repeal of Ordinance No. 827 and the abolishment of the requirement of city stickers for the operation of motor vehicles upon the city streets of the City of London, Kentucky; and
- . WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of London is in agreement with the Mayor's recommendations,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of London, Kentucky as follows:

Ordinance No. 827 and any and all ordinances which established city stickers for the operation of Motor Vehicles upon the city streets of the City of London by and is hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be effective on the 1st day of January, 1998.
