ORDINANCE NO. 933

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LONDON UTILITY COMMISSION TO  
ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH OTHER DISTRICTS AND ESTABLISH  
WHOLESALE WATER AND WHOLESALE WASTEWATER TREATMENT RATES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The London Utility Commission is now, and has for many years provided wholesale water to other water districts. The expense to the London Utility Commission varies and has increased over the years and the London Utility Commission has sought and obtained from the London City Council ordinances changes and amendments necessary to reflect the increases in the wholesale water rate.
2. There is presently no existing rate ordinance by the London City Council for charging for wastewater treatment by the London Utility Commission of wastewater of other districts.
3. Due to the constant change in expenses to the London Utility Commission in providing both wholesale water as well as wholesale wastewater treatment, the rate structure of any ordinance will constantly change. At the present time, the contracts that exist are reviewed on an annual basis and renegotiated on an annual basis.
4. Both wholesale water and wholesale wastewater treatment have been and will continue to be provided to the other districts in a manner that is at a profit to the City of London.
5. Rather than this matter being continually presented to the City Council of the City of London, by this ordinance, the City Council of the City of London hereby authorizes the London Utility Commission with its full and complete authority to set and establish rates of providing wholesale water and wholesale wastewater treatment to other districts and to enter into such contract negotiations with other districts, but to do so in a manner that is the financial benefit of the citizens of London, Kentucky.
6. This authority is for wholesale water and wholesale wastewater treatment only, and does not in any manner effect the individual service rates, charges and fees being charged of customers of the London Utility Commissioner under the present rate structure.

7. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
