ORDINANCE NO. 960**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RESIDENTIAL MONTHLY  
RATE FOR THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE**

Whereas, Ordinance No. 873 established that the residential pick-up of garbage will be made once a week in conformity with regular schedules fixed by the Sanitation Department, and,

Whereas all residents of the City of London will within the next short while be provided with containers within which they are to place their garbage, said containers being uniform in design and the same are believed to be of a nature so as to reduce injuries to the employees of the City Sanitation Department, now,

Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. All garbage at residential pick-ups will be placed in a collection container to be provided by the City of London.
2. The rate for each single family unit and for each family unit in a multi family dwelling, including apartment houses, shall be \$10.00 per month for each family unit.
3. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
