

**COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY
CITY OF LONDON KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 964**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATES, CHARGES AND FEES FOR WATER SERVICE AND SEWER SERVICE SUPPLIED TO CUSTOMERS OF THE CITY OF LONDON WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 2, Section 3, Section 4, Section 5, Section 6, and Section 7 of City of London Ordinance No. 875 be and is hereby replaced. No other Sections or parts of City of London Ordinance No. 875 are effected by this ordinance and all other portions remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. The following definitions shall be applicable to this Ordinance.

(a) Customer means the owner or occupier of a residential, commercial, or industrial unit or facility to which water service and/or sewer service is furnished by the City of London Utility Commission.

(b) Utility Commission means the City of London Utility Commission.

SECTION 3. Each customer of the water system located inside the city limits shall have a separate water meter and shall pay a monthly meter service charge, which shall include the first 2,000 gallons, based on the size of the meter as follows:

<u>SIZE OF SERVICE</u>	<u>SERVICE CHARGE PER MONTH</u>
5/8 inch meter or less	\$ 7.60
¾ inch meter	\$ 7.60
1 inch meter	\$ 9.39
1-¼ or 1-½ inch meter	\$ 17.02
2 inch meter	\$ 28.07
3 inch meter	\$ 55.25
4 inch meter	\$ 85.09
6 inch meter	\$ 168.51

SECTION 4. Each customer located inside the City limits shall pay the following monthly rates for water supplied in addition to the monthly meter service charge stated in Section 2:

For the first 2,000 gallons, minimum monthly meter charge.

For the next 4,000 gallons, \$2.39 per 1,000 gallons

For the next 14,000 gallons, \$2.11 per 1,000 gallons

For the next 80,000 gallons, \$1.86 per 1,000 gallons

For the next 100,000 gallons, \$1.58 per 1,000 gallons
 For the next 800,000 gallons, \$1.55 per 1,000 gallons
 Over 1,000,000 gallons, \$1.49 per 1,000 gallons.

SECTION 5. Each customer of the water system located outside the city limits shall have a separate water meter and shall pay a monthly meter service charge, which shall include the first 2,000 gallons, based on the size of the meter as follows:

<u>SIZE OF SERVICE</u>	<u>SERVICE CHARGE PER MONTH</u>
5/8 inch meter or less	11.40
¾ inch meter	11.40
1 inch meter	14.03
1-¼ or 1-½ inch meter	25.53
2 inch meter	42.10
3 inch meter	82.99
4 inch meter	127.63
6 inch meter	252.71

SECTION 6. Each customer located outside the city limits shall pay the following monthly rates for water supplied in addition to the monthly meter service charge stated in Section 4:

For the first 2,000 gallons, minimum monthly meter charge
 For the next 4,000 gallons, \$3.57 per 1,000 gallons
 For the next 14,000 gallons, \$3.16 per 1,000 gallons
 For the next 80,000 gallons, \$2.80 per 1,000 gallons
 For the next 100,000 gallons, \$2.39 per 1,000 gallons
 For the next 800,000 gallons, \$2.32 per 1,000 gallons
 Over 1,000,000 gallons, \$2.24 per 1,000 gallons.

SECTION 6.1 Each wholesale customer shall pay \$1.35 per 1,000 gallons water supplied.

SECTION 7. Each customer of the sewer system located inside the city limits shall pay a monthly minimum service charge of \$3.96 which shall include the charge for the first 2,000 gallons of waste. The rate schedule for the sewer charges for each customer located inside the city shall be as follows:

For the first 2,000 gallons, fifty two percent (52%) of the applicable monthly meter charge as is outlined in Section 2.

- For the next 4,000 gallons, \$1.24 per 1,000 gallons
- For the next 14,000 gallons, \$1.09 per 1,000 gallons
- For the next 80,000 gallons, \$0.97 per 1,000 gallons
- For the next 100,000 gallons, \$0.83 per 1,000 gallons
- For the next 800,000 gallons, \$0.81 per 1,000 gallons
- Over 1,000,000 gallons, \$0.77 per 1,000 gallons

The above rates shall be increased by \$1.65 per 1,000 gallons for domestic waste for the operation and maintenance portion of the billing to compute the monthly sewer charge.

SECTION 8. Each customer of the sewer system located outside the city limits shall pay a monthly minimum service charge of \$5.93 which shall include the charge for the first 2,000 gallons of waste. The rate schedule for the sewer charge for each customer located outside the city limits shall be as follows:

For the first 2,000 gallons, fifty two percent (52%) of the applicable monthly meter charge as is outlined in Section 4.

- For the next 4,000 gallons, \$1.86 per 1,000 gallons
- For the next 14,000 gallons, \$1.65 per 1,000 gallons
- For the next 80,000 gallons, \$1.56 per 1,000 gallons
- For the next 100,000 gallons, \$1.24 per 1,000 gallons
- For the next 800,000 gallons \$1.20 per 1,000 gallons
- Over 1,000,000 gallons \$1.17 per \$1,000 gallons

The above rates shall be increased by \$1.65 per 1,000 gallons for domestic waste for the operation and maintenance portion of the billing to compute the monthly sewer charge.

SECTION 9. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
