
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 911, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SOLICITING CONTRIBUTIONS ON STREETS, ALLEYS, ROADS AND RIGHT OF WAYS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF LONDON, KENTUCKY"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

That Ordinance No. 911 be and is hereby amended as follows:

1. KRS 189.590(20) prohibits any person from standing on a road right of way for the purpose of soliciting contributions unless such soliciting is designated by the presence of traffic control device or warning signal or an emergency vehicle or public safety vehicle as defined in KRS 189.910, making use of the flashing, rotating or oscillating lights on such devices or vehicles. A violation of this state law is punishable as a state offense by a fine of twenty dollars (\$20.00) to one hundred dollars (\$100.00), pursuant to KRS 189.990(1).
2. In addition to KRS 189.570(21) as are stated herein above, in the interest of public safety and welfare the City of London does hereby further regulate the solicitation of monetary contributions being made on street, alleys, roads, and right of ways within the City of London, Kentucky; as follows:
 - a. No solicitation of monetary contributions by any person, group, or organization shall be allowed upon any city street, alley, road or right of ways within the City Limits of the City of London, Kentucky.
 - b. Persons seeking political office may solicit votes by passing out campaign materials with the City of London, in compliance with the requirements of KRS 189.570 (21), but may not seek monetary contributions.
 - c. No person under the age of eighteen (18) years of age may participate in any political solicitation of votes for a political candidate, pursuant to this Ordinance.
 - d. Any violation of this Ordinance shall result in a fine of not less than twenty (\$20.00) dollars and not more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars. Each violation shall be considered a separate offense.
3. Any other portion of Ordinance No. 911 not specifically amended herein remains in full force and effect. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

4. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication.
