AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AN UNDEVELOPED ALLEYWAY OF COYE KING AND BARBARA KING AND WINDSOR FOREST, INC.

Whereas, the City Council has been requested to close an undeveloped alleyway, and


Whereas, the provisions of KRS 82.405 have been followed, and

Whereas, the London City Council has made Findings of Fact pursuant to KRS 82.405, these findings being that the only property owners in or abutting the alleyway as described in that certain deed dated February 23, 1993 of record in Deed Book 414, at page 180 records of the Laurel County Court Clerk's Office, are Coye King and Barbara King, and Windsor Forest, Inc., and both have consented in writing and requested that this undeveloped alleyway be closed.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY, that he undeveloped alleyway of the Coye King property as it is identified in the deed dated February 23, 1993 of record in Deed Book 414, at page 180, BE AND IS HEREBY CLOSED.


THIS ORDINANCE shall become effective immediately upon publication and shall be recorded in the office of the Laurel County Court Clerk.
