
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A THREE-WAY STOP AT INTERSECTION OF
SHORT STREET AND MILL STREET

WHEREAS, the residential and commercial development has caused an increased flow of traffic in the area of the intersection of Short Street and Mill Street, and the same has caused potentially unsafe conditions to exist,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

That stop signs shall be and the Street Department of the City of London is hereby directed to erect in three (3) locations stop signs, creating a three (3) way stop of traffic at the intersection of Short Street and Mill Street.

This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
