AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF AMARILLO DRIVE TO
SHILOH DRIVE

Whereas, there exists a street that is located on the Hal Rogers Parkway Russell Dyché Memorial Highway that is currently named Amarillo Drive. Property owners have requested the City of London rename this street to be called Shiloh Drive.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the following street be and is hereby renamed Shiloh Drive. This street was previously known as Amarillo Drive.
2. This street begins at the intersection of Shiloh Drive and Alamo Drive.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That this street be and is hereby named Shiloh Drive.
2. That the City Street Department shall erect signs in keeping with this Ordinance.
3. That this street named is given the name of Shiloh Drive and it is intended that the City will provide maintenance to this street.
4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
