AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 673 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF
THE CITY OF LONDON RELATING TO UNFAIR HOUSING
PRACTICES, FINANCIAL PRACTICES AND BLOCKBUSTING AND
CREATING A LOCAL HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION"

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of London, Kentucky, has decided to repeal City of London Ordinance No. 673, entitled, "An Ordinance of the City of London Relating to Unfair Housing Practices, Financial Practices and Blockbusting and Creating a Local Human Rights Commission".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, as follows:

City of London Ordinance No. 673 is hereby repealed.

If any section, clause, sentence, or phrase of the Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any portion thereof, other than the section so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication in accordance with the applicable provisions of Kentucky law. Any Ordinances or part of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
