

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LONDON TO COMPLETE A FY2023 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM APPLICATION AND TO AUTHORIZE MAYOR RANDALL WEDDLE AND SUCCESSORS IN TITLE TO SIGN ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION ADMINISTRATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF SAID PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of London proposes to construct new shared use sidewalks along US 25N (Main Street) from London Elementary School to Chinook Drive, in London, Kentucky, that will enable students and parents to walk safely to and from the School, the residents of Laurel Heights Nursing Home to use to walk as needed and the citizens to use to walk in the north area of London,

WHEREAS, the City of London intends to make an application to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for assistance under the Transportation Alternatives Program, and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Alternatives Program is limited to funding a maximum of eighty percent (80%) of proposed project costs estimated at \$5,000,000.00 and the City of London intends to submit an application in the amount of \$4,000,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the remaining balance for the proposed project of \$5,000,000.00 will be provided by the City of London.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of London will hold in reserve the estimated balance of \$1,000,000.00 for the purpose of matching the Transportation Alternatives Program assistance, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mayor Randall Weddle and Successors-in-Title, are hereby authorized to execute and submit applications through the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's Transportation Alternatives Program for the sidewalk construction project in London, and are hereby authorized as the City's Official Project Representative to carry out necessary negotiations for and administer the assistance the applicant may obtain from the Transportation Alternatives Program.
